In order to be ready in September to talk about these questions, we ask you to choose one of the following works to read over the summer:

or

or

You can obtain these works from Amazon, Barnes and Noble and other places where fine works of literature are sold. You may also find a few of them on iBooks or your Nook.

While reading your selected novel, please keep in mind the following two questions that are relevant to the theme:

Is experience attained at the expense of innocence?

What effect does regret have on growing up?

Feel free to highlight and annotate (make notes in the margins) your book or keep a journal of your thoughts about these questions as you read the work.
