## Follow this easy online ordering process:

1. On your computer (not smartphone or tablet), go to [yearbookforever.com](http://yearbookforever.com), enter **Ma'ayanot Yeshiva** to find our school, and click on **Create a Personal ad**.
2. Enter your **Student First Name**, **Student Last Name**, and **Grade (12th Grade)** and select Next.
3. Decide how you want to design your ad.

### Option 1 : Upload My Finished Ad

- Before going online, create your ad. Save it as a JPG or PNG file with a minimum resolution of 150 dpi (300 dpi is recommended). Select your desired ad size and follow the directions to upload.

### Option 2 : Design My Own Ad Online

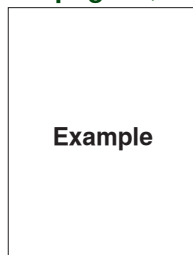
- Follow the directions to select your ad size and design. Then uplaode your photos adn enter your message into the template. You can also changes fonts and background colors at this time.
- **Note:** Ads must be finished in one session. Be sure to complete your purchase after designing your ad. You will NOT be able to return to the store later to revise or buy your ad.

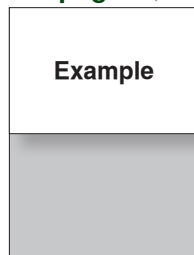
File formats accepted: JPG, PNG, TIFF in RGB color mode. Images cannot exceed 25 MB.

4. Decide on the ad size you want to buy.

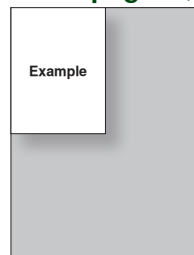
**Full page - \$250**



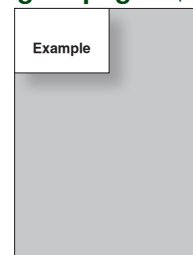
**Half page - \$150**
